GUIDELINES

These guidelines are not meant to be exhaustive but to promote a healthy environment. By coming to Soldiers of the Cross, you agree to support the following:

- All dress should be plain and simple. Try to stay away from all stylish fits and cuts. No lettering on coats, shirts, jackets, or sweaters.
- Dress for the ladies needs to be modest and loose-fitting. Dresses should be a full-length pattern including a cape or double-layered blouse. All jackets and sweaters should open in the front (no pull-overs, please). Your covering should be of adequate size to cover your hair well. If the hanging veil is worn, it should be of solid material, either black or white.
- Dress for the men should be modest as well with no form-fitting shirts. We ask that no t-shirts be worn and that all shirts have collars. Dress for Sunday and all evening services should be long-sleeve button-down shirts and dress pants.
- Media. We ask that no personal dvds would be brought. Use all other media such as cell phones, laptops, and iPads in moderation.
- Curfew. Please respect all curfew times. This is for your benefit as well as the benefit of all those who enjoy sleep.
- Dorms. We ask that you would respect the segregated dorm areas and only have mixed fellowship in public areas.
- Campus. Please stay on campus unless you have permission to leave from one of the committee members.
- We ask that you follow the guidelines set forth from your church on all areas that we don't cover.
